THE ALGERNON SYDNEY SULLIVAN AWARD AND THE MARY MILDRED SULLIVAN AWARD

The Algernon Sydney Sullivan Award and the Mary Mildred Sullivan Award are given to the man and woman of the graduating class who, in the judgment of the President of the College, best exemplify the traits of the late Mr. and Mrs. Sullivan, individuals of faith, hope, and charity.

THE GEORGE B. CROMER AWARD

In memory of Dr. George B. Cromer, President of Newberry College from 1895-1904, the Class of 1938 first gave an award to the graduating senior who, in the judgment of the faculty, has exemplified the qualities of Dr. Cromer: academic excellence, leadership ability, and personal integrity.

BACHMAN HONOR SOCIETY

The Bachman Honor Society was founded on March 15, 1962, by a group of faculty who were members of Phi Beta Kappa and others who were deeply committed to fostering high standards of scholarship. The society is named for the Reverend John Bachman, D.D., churchman and scholar, and the main guiding force in the founding of Newberry College in 1856. Each year the Society inducts new members from the top eight percent of the senior class.

David L. “Buddy” Morgan

Founder, President and Chief Executive Officer of Litton Entertainment (1989-2021)



Litton Entertainment is recognized as a world-class producer and distributor of Emmy Award-winning network television programming. They have received a total of 89 Emmy nominations with 15 wins. Mr. Morgan’s television shows currently air on ABC, CBS, NBC, The CW and Telemundo in the US and in 97 countries worldwide. Mr. Morgan’s television series are seen yearly by 1 billion global viewers.

Litton’s ‘Gold Standard’ family-friendly educational television programs comprise the bulk of Litton’s library that spans 30 years of production in 34 TV series, amassing 4,000 episodes and garnering 500 Parent Choice Awards and Telly awards.

Mr. Morgan completed a sale of Litton Entertainment and its assets to The Hearst Corporation in January 2022.

Although most of Mr. Morgan’s television shows have appealed to American families on Saturday mornings, his television career has included popular programs that include many genres. The most popular shows include *The Inspectors* on CBS; ABC’s *Jack Hanna’s Animal Adventures*; and NBC’s *Earth Odyssey with Dylan Dryer*, *Lucky Dog* and *Innovation Nation*. He has also produced the Weather Channel’s *Storm Stories* and FX’s *Toughman*.

Mr. Morgan has served as a board member of the MUSC Children’s Hospital for 18 years and of the College of Charleston School of Business for 16 years. While serving as an adjunct professor at the College of Charleston, Morgan taught a course he created for business school seniors titled, “The Business of Television.”

The Morgan Family Foundation has been a strong supporter of Newberry College, especially with support of our student retention and student success efforts. Mr. Morgan lives in Charleston, S.C. and has been married to Lissy Morgan for 34 years. They have three children (Katie, Dillon and Henry) and welcomed grandson Buddy Lyon to the world in 2021. Youngest son Henry Morgan is a proud 2017 graduate of Newberry College.
