THE DR. L. GRADY COOPER AWARD

Each year, the senior class selects a student who best exemplifies the loyalty and devotion to Newberry College that Dr. L. Grady Cooper showed during his long tenure as Professor of Religion and Greek.

THE ALGERNON SYDNEY SULLIVAN AWARD AND THE MARY MILDRED SULLIVAN AWARD

The Algernon Sydney Sullivan Award and the Mary Mildred Sullivan Award are given to the man and woman of the graduating class who, in the judgment of the President of the College, best exemplify the traits of the late Mr. and Mrs. Sullivan, individuals of faith, hope, and charity.

THE GEORGE B. CROMER AWARD

In memory of Dr. George B. Cromer, President of Newberry College from 1895-1904, the Class of 1938 first gave an award to the graduating senior who, in the judgment of the faculty, exemplified the qualities of Dr. Cromer: academic excellence, leadership ability, and personal integrity.

BACHMAN HONOR SOCIETY

The Bachman Honor Society was founded on March 15, 1962, by a group of faculty who were members of Phi Beta Kappa and others who were deeply committed to fostering high standards of scholarship. The society is named for the Rev. John Bachman, D.D., churchman and scholar, and the main guiding force in the founding of Newberry College in 1856. Each year the Society inducts new members from the top eight percent of the senior class, as well as distinguished members of the faculty.

SUMMERLAND HONORS COMMUNITY
