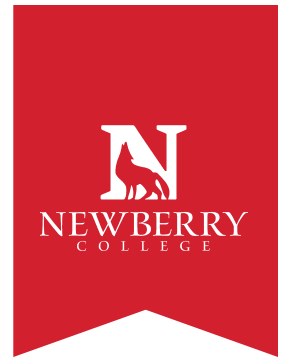

Newberry College Transfer Guide

Finish your degree. Start your career. Whether you've taken a few classes or you're earning an associate's degree, you have an important decision to make about where to transfer those hard-earned credits to complete your bachelor's degree. Our Transfer Guide will walk you through the basics of the application process, credit evaluation, financial aid and more.

Apply for transfer admission. It's simple!

- 1. Complete the transfer application.** Go to www.newberry.edu/admission to complete the online application for transfer students. To make it even easier, we've eliminated the application fee and the letter of recommendation requirement.
- 2. Submit transcripts.** Students transferring 24 college credit hours or more only need to submit college transcripts. Students transferring less than 24 credit hours should submit high school transcripts.

It's that easy! Newberry College's rolling admission policy means we'll give you an admission decision as soon as your required materials arrive.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

If you have taken college-level course work AFTER graduation from high school, you are considered a transfer applicant. You can apply for transfer admission with any number of credits completed at other institutions. Transfer applicants need:

- A minimum 2.0 GPA (out of 4.0)
- Submit required transcripts. Students who submit SAT or ACT scores may be eligible for enhanced financial aid.

Transferring with an Associate's Degree: If you've completed an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree following the University Transfer program of study, you will transfer to Newberry College with junior level standing.

What's next?

Once you've applied to Newberry College, you're on the home stretch. We recommend the following steps to ensure your transfer to Newberry College STAYS simple:

Get a credit evaluation. Not sure how your credits will transfer to Newberry College? We'll do an informal transcript credit evaluation to give you an idea of how the credits you're transferring fulfill our program requirements and give you a roadmap for completing the remainder of your bachelor's degree with us.

Apply for financial aid. Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at www.fafsa.edu.gov. Not only does the FAFSA determine your eligibility for Federal and State grants and loans, it also helps us factor institutional scholarships you may receive directly from Newberry College.

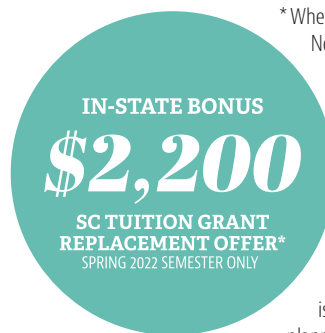
Attend New Student Orientation. Once you're admitted, it's helpful to attend Wolf Pack Welcome, to get the inside track on what you need to succeed at Newberry College. You'll have an opportunity to interact with faculty & fellow students, finalize your semester course schedule and develop an official plan for your future at Newberry College.

TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIPS

Newberry College offers a generous financial aid package including scholarships especially for transfer students.

SCHOLARSHIP CATEGORY	GPA REQUIREMENT	RESIDENTIAL	OFF-CAMPUS
Trustee's Transfer Scholarship	3.5 or higher	\$15,000	\$11,000
Founder's Transfer Scholarship	3.0 – 3.5	\$12,500	\$9,000
Presidential Scholarship	2.5 – 3.0	\$11,000	\$8,000
Dean's Transfer Scholarship	2.0 – 2.5	\$10,000	\$7,000

In addition to our generous transfer scholarship package, South Carolina residents transferring to Newberry College for Spring Semester 2022 also will receive our SC Tuition Grant Replacement offer. PLUS, you may be eligible for other state-funded scholarships, such as SC Life, SC Life Enhancement, SC Hope, SC Palmetto Fellows and SC Palmetto Fellows Enhancement.



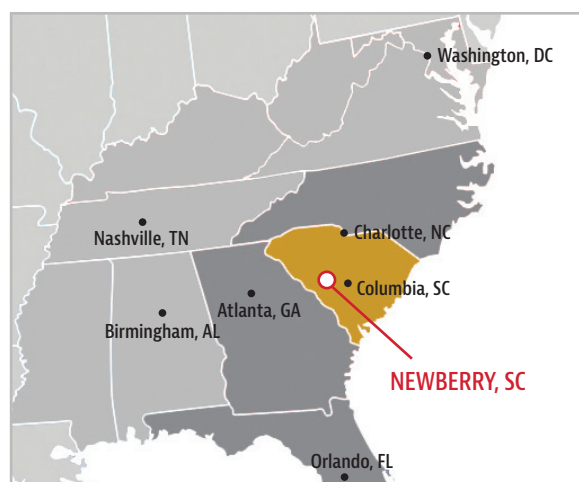
*When you attend a private college like Newberry College, you could be eligible for the South Carolina Tuition Grant (SCTG), an annual grant of \$4,390 awarded each fall by the State of South Carolina. If a South Carolina student does not receive the spring portion of the SC Tuition Grant, Newberry College will add a \$2,200 grant replacement to the student's financial package. This special offer is only available for transfer students planning to start at Newberry College for the Spring 2022 semester, so apply now!
