Transcript Fee (incorrect costs listed previously)

A student requesting an **unofficial** copy of his/her transcript will be charged \$1.00 for each copy. A student requesting an **official** transcript will be charged \$5.00 per transcript requested. An additional \$2.00 fee is charged for faxed transcripts.

Transcripts (incorrect costs listed previously, addition of link)

Transcripts will be issued by the Registrar upon the receipt of a signed request by the student or alumnus. Transcript requests are also available through Parchment at <https://www.newberry.edu/academics/registrar> . Requests may be sent either electronically or by paper. Many institutions will not accept transcripts that were received by the student and forwarded to the school. It is the responsibility of the student to verify an institution's policies before requesting a transcript. A credit card is necessary to place an electronic request. Transcripts dated before 1991 cannot be sent electronically.

A student requesting an **unofficial** copy of his/her transcript will be charged \$1.00 for each copy. A student requesting an **official** transcript will be charged \$5.00 per transcript requested. An additional \$2.00 fee is charged for faxed transcripts.

The college will not issue a partial record; all failures, incomplete grades, and academic restrictions are shown. Transcripts will indicate if a student withdrew from Newberry College because of academic ineligibility or disciplinary action.

No transcript will be issued for students in default of the payment of college fees or charges.

Sociology Course (corrected course title)

218 Sociology of Education (3) [SB]

This course will explore sociological research and theories that are useful for conducting a critical examination of educational institutions and practices in the United States. Students will examine the ways in which schools reinforce and/or challenge prevailing social, economic, and political relationships through discussions of topics including educational inequality, the dynamics of race, class, and gender in education, standardized testing, school choice, and higher education. The course will focus on the ways that social inequalities are reproduced through schools, and the way that identities are formed through education. *Offered at the department's discretion.*
