* Online Orientation is offered every term and must be completed before the student takes his or her first course through Newberry Online.

** Transfer students must complete at least one Writing Intensive (WI) course at Newberry College. Students transferring in with a sophomore classification must complete three WI courses; junior classification must complete two WI courses; senior classification must complete one WI course, which must be taken at Newberry College. Credit for up to two WI courses may be awarded from equivalent courses completed at other institutions.

BSRT DEGREE-COMPLETION COURSES

All RES courses in the BSRT degree-completion program are taught once per year (see Curriculum Plan) but can be taken in any sequence. A grade of "C" or better is required for in all BSRT degree-completion track courses. Courses may be taken on a full-time or part-time basis; however, the last 30 credits of the degree (designated as the senior year) must be completed at Newberry College.
