

Psychology Degree-Completion Roadmap

To graduate with Bachelor of Arts in Psychology degree from Newberry College, you must complete 120 total credit hours. You must successfully complete 45 credit hours at other institutions before enrolling in the online degree-completion program. Up to 72 credit hours of completed coursework is eligible for transfer to Newberry College: 18 hours of Psychology coursework and 50 hours of General Education coursework.

* Online Orientation is offered every term and must be completed before the student takes his or her first course through Newberry Online.

** Transfer students must complete at least one Writing Intensive (WI) course at Newberry College. Students transferring in with a sophomore classification must complete three WI courses; junior classification must complete two WI courses; senior classification must complete one WI course, which must be taken at Newberry College. Credit for up to two WI courses may be awarded from equivalent courses completed at other institutions.

TRANSFER CREDITS

You may transfer up to 72 credit hours of previously completed coursework: 18 hours of Psychology coursework and 50 hours of General Education coursework. Transfer credits may be used to fulfill Newberry College's Liberal Arts Core and General Education requirements.
